

Chief Justice J&K Gita Mittal inaugurates new building of school of Law at KU Campus

Interacts with KU, CUK law students during concluding ceremony of internship-placement program

Srinagar, Dec 16: The School of Law, University of Kashmir & School of Legal Studies, Central University of Kashmir in collaboration with District Legal Service Authority, Srinagar organised an Internship and Placement Programme at University of Kashmir on 14th & 15th of December, 2018.

The Concluding Ceremony of the Programme was held on Sunday , in the EMMRC Auditorium, University of Kashmir.
