

TEN DAYS *SILAI* TRAINING PROGRAM BEGINS AT KU



KU-28th January: The Department of Social Work at the University of Kashmir has started a ten days training program on USHA SILAI SCHOOL in collaboration with USHA International, New Delhi.

The purpose of program is to train the women belonging to neglected communities by supporting them with Skill, Training and Equipment's. The training shall be imparted to 20 Participants of Ganderbal District from 28th Jan to 6th Feb 2020.
