

# Prof Geer Mohammad Ishaq is new Director of KU's CCPC

**Srinagar, June 21:** Prof Geer Mohammad Ishaq from Kashmir University's Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences has taken over as new Director of the varsity's Centre for Career Planning and Counselling (CCPC).
