

KU's CCPC to organise 3-day mentoring workshop on 'study abroad' from Aug 29-31

Srinagar, Aug 27: The Centre for Career Planning and Counselling (CCPC) University of Kashmir is organising a three-day mentoring and capacity-building workshop on 'Career Opportunities Abroad' in collaboration with Project Eduaccess from August 29 to 31.

“More than 1500 registrations have been received so far from different schools, colleges and universities of Kashmir.
