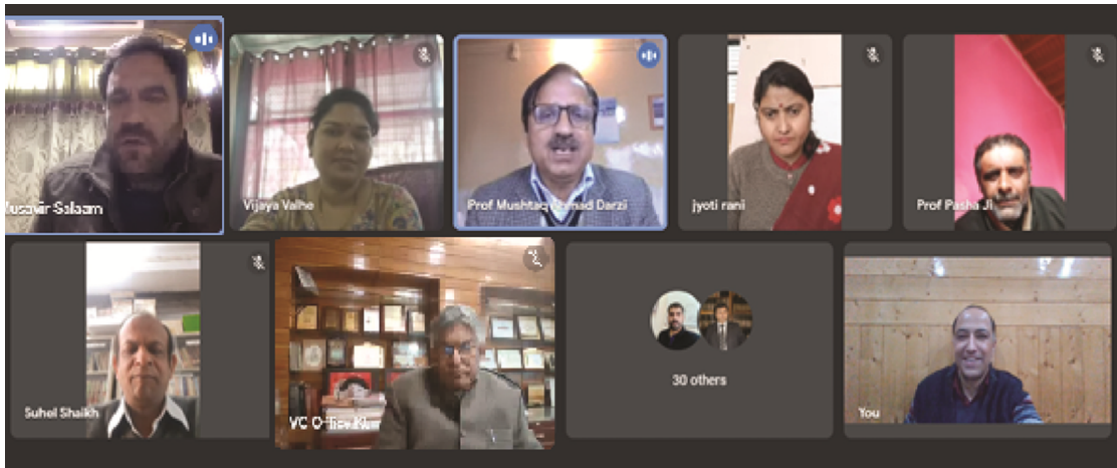


Prof Talat inaugurates Refresher Course in Arts, Humanities at KU's HRDC



Srinagar, Feb 3: A Refresher Course in the disciplines of Arts, Languages, Law and Humanities started at the University of Kashmir.

Vice-Chancellor Prof Talat Ahmad inaugurated the online course, organised by the varsity's UGC- Human Resource Development Centre (HRDC).
