

Inter-college women's table tennis tournament concludes at KU



Srinagar July 29: The inter-college women's table tennis tournament concluded at the University of Kashmir on Friday.

The tournament was organised by the Directorate of Physical Education and Sports (DPES). More than 100 participants from 19 affiliated colleges took part in the five-day event.

The final match was played between Women's College Baramulla and GDC Tangmarg, wherein GDC Tangmarg defeated Women's College Baramulla by 2 sets to 1 (2-1).

In Singles, Bisma Ali of Women's College Baramulla defeated Amreena Hafiz by 2-0, whereas Shabnam Shafi of GDC Tangmarg defeated Benazir Akhtar by 2-0. In Doubles, Amreen and Shabnam of GDC Tangmarg won the set by 2-0, thereby clinching the tournament by 2-1.
