

KU's Disability Resource Centre organises interaction session with specially-abled students, research scholars



Srinagar, June 24: Continuing with its general student interaction programme, the Department of Students' Welfare University of Kashmir on Friday interacted with the varsity's specially-abled students and research scholars.
