

# SMC conducts sanitation/fumigation drive at KU's main Campus

**Srinagar, March 15:** As part of the precautionary measures against Coronavirus threat Srinagar Municipal Corporation conducted a fumigation drive at main campus University of Kashmir here on Sunday.
