

KU submits first phase of documents for re-accreditation by NAAC

Srinagar, November 01: Vice Chancellor University of Kashmir (KU) Prof. Talat Ahmad chaired a high level meeting to review the data and documents to be submitted to NAAC for 3rd reaccreditation cycle after the University had already submitted the Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA) in the first phase.

It is pertinent to mention that the University was accredited with Grade 'A' in previous accreditation cycle and it is making its all efforts to improve its ranking in the upcoming cycle.

The University, nevertheless, has been recently ranked high in the world QS ranking and was ranked in top 50 Universities of the country by the MHRD under the NIRF.
