

## 2-week workshop on Research Methodology & Data Analysis concludes at KU

**Srinagar, Oct 12:** A two-week workshop on 'Research Methodology and Data Analysis in Commerce, Management and Social Sciences' concluded at the University of Kashmir.

Registrar Dr Nisar Ahmad Mir was chief guest at the valedictory function, where Dean Colleges Development Council Prof Mohi-ud-Din Sangmi was a special invitee who presided over the function. Speaking on the occasion, Dr
