

Prof GM Sangmi is new Director Distance Education KU, Prof Raies Qadri Dean Students welfare

Srinagar, Sept 15: Prof Ghulam Mohi-ud-Din Dar (Sangmi) from the Department of Commerce University of Kashmir has been appointed as new Director Directorate of Distance Education (DDE) whereas Prof Raies A Qadri from the Department of Biotechnology KU has been appointed as new Dean Students Welfare, University of Kashmir.

Meanwhile in another order issued on Sept 12, 2018 Prof Raies A Qadri has been appointed as Dean Students Welfare thereby relieving Prof GN Khaki from the additional charge as DSW.
