

On World Disability Day DSW, KU organises interaction with specially-abled students

Srinagar, Dec 03: On the eve of World Disability Day, the Department of Students Welfare (DSW) University of Kashmir organized a general interaction meet with the specially abled students of the university here on Monday.

Around 50 students from different post graduate departments as well as some research scholars participated in the interaction which was chaired by Prof. Raies A Qadri, Dean Students Welfare and was attended by different officials of DSW also.
