

Inter-College table tennis tournament concludes at KU; Islamia College emerges winner



Srinagar, Aug 5: The final match of the Inter-College Table Tennis Tournament (Men) was played between Islamia College of Science and Commerce and Gandhi Memorial College at the University of Kashmir on Friday.

The tournament was organised by KU's Directorate of Physical Education and Sports (DPES).

The Islamia College defeated Gandhi Memorial College by 2 games to nil.
