MoE-sponsored workshop on 'Glossary of Electronics Engineering' concludes at KU

Srinagar, May 22: A five-day workshop on 'Fundamental Glossary of Electronics Engineering (English-Hindi-Kashmiri)' was organised by the Commission for Scientific and Technical Terminology (CSTT), Ministry of Education (Department of Higher Education), New Delhi, in association with the University of Kashmir. The workshop was held at the Department of Electronics and Instrumentation Technology, KU.

Earlier, Registrar of the University Dr Nisar Ahmad Mir inaugurated the workshop and highlighted its importance in the context of New Education Policy and emphasised that such workshops are also needed in other Science and Social Science subjects.

In the workshop, approximately 2900 electronics terms are to be translated into the Kashmiri language.
