

KU holds review meeting for DYD at IoT Zakura Campus



Srinagar, November 19: The Institute of Technology (IoT), Zakura Campus, University of Kashmir (KU), on Wednesday held a review meeting for the Centre for Design Your Degree (CDYD), which currently offers an interdisciplinary learning pathway to students.
