

Free diagnostic camp for employees held at KU



Srinagar, Sep 19: The department of Clinical Biochemistry, University of Kashmir, on Monday organised a free diagnostic-cum-screening camp in collaboration with University Health Centre for the varsity employees.

Vice-Chancellor Prof Nilofer Khan visited the camp, organised by the department as its annual feature, and expressed her satisfaction over active involvement of the department's students in the pro-employees endeavour.

Asserting that such programmes should also be held outside the university for common people in no-profit no-loss basis, Prof Nilofer said the initiative could vastly benefit the student community and the department to develop a strong societal connect.
